## HOW TO READ THIS DOCUMENT

As planned Continuous Monitoring was to use an instrument which varied only slightly during the interviewing period Jan 11-Dec. 7. Rather more changes in the instrument have taken place than originally anticipated, largely because the Democratic nomination was contested more strongly than expected, and the whole, with exceptions relating to candidacy, the basic instrument has remained quite stable.

The eighth version of Continuous Monitoring is now in the field. At least one more version, a post-election instrument, is planned. The differences from version to version range from very minor to noticeable, (see below). Part I of the document lists all of the questions which have been in all of the versions. Questions which have undergone minor changes in wording -- shifts in tense to account for passage of time -- are included in this portion. Part II lists all of the questions which have been in some but not all versions of the questionnaire. An "x" in the column headed "4" means that a question appeared in version 4. Ferraro name recognition, for example, was asked in versions 6, 7 and 8. Cuomo name recognition was asked in versions 5, 6 and 7.

A composite questionnaire for versions 1-4 is now available, and there will be a composite questionnaire incorporating all versions when the complete dataset is released in the summer of 1985. A dataset for versions 1-4 will be available through the Consortium immediately following the Nov. 6, 1984 election.
