Ratings between 50 degrees and 100 degrees mean that you feel favorable and warm toward the person or group. Ratings between 0 degrees and 50 degrees mean that you don't feel favorable toward the person or group and that you don't care too much for that person or group. You would rate the person or group at the 50 degree mark if you don't feel particularly warm or cold toward them.

If we come to a person or group whose name you don't recognize, you don't need to rate that person or group. Just click on the forward arrow and we'll move on to the next one.
