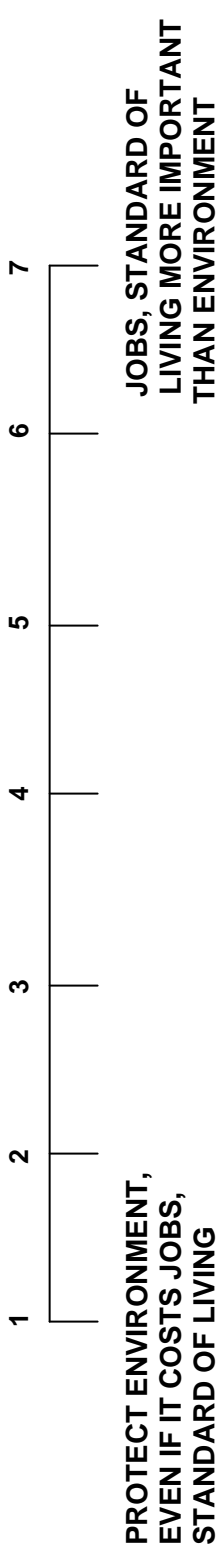


## Government Help to Blacks

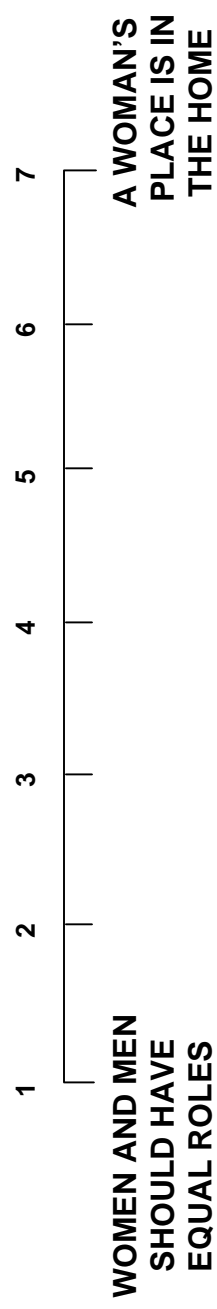


1. People who make more money should pay a larger percent of their income in taxes to the government than people who make less money.

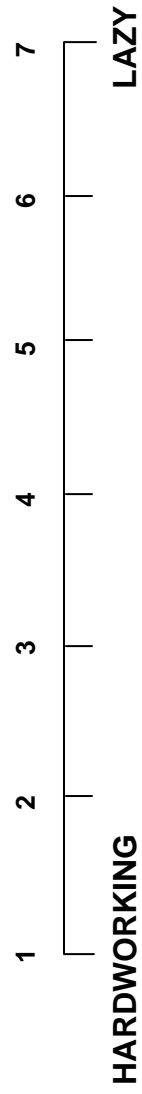

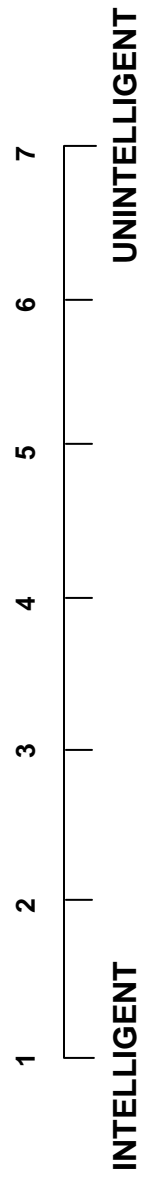
