>> 2000 PILOT STUDY DESCRIPTION

>> STRATIFICATION AND SELECTION OF RESPONDENTS FOR THE 2000 PILOT SAMPLE

The sample for the 2000 Pilot comprised a selection of cases from the 1998 NES Post-election study. The 2000 Pilot selection procedure first grouped all 1998 respondents according to Low, Low-Medium, Medium, Medium-High, or High level of political knowledge and interest (PKI). Then, within each group of cases, those respondents for whom current telephone-contact information were not known were removed, and a predetermined number of the remaining respondents in each group was randomly selected for the Pilot sample.

The number of cases for selection had been calculated for each group so that anticipated response rates within groups would produce the same target number of completed interviews from every group, that is, the same number of interviews at each level of political knowledge-interest.

1998 Respondents were assigned an overall PKI ranking which was produced using R's separate rankings for:

- Political Knowledge (scale 1-100)
- Political Interest (scale 1-100)

Political Knowledge (PK)

9 items from the 1998 Post-election study were used to construct a variable which rated respondents' level of political knowledge:

The Knowledge score was constructed for questions answered by R:
total no. points/total no. points possible

This result was multiplied by 100 and rounded to the next whole integer.
For example, if R only answered questions corresponding to 7 items and his
response total was 400, then his Knowledge score would be $400/700 = .571 * 100$
= 57.1 or 57.

Political Interest (PI)

2 items from the 1998 post were used to create the score for level of
Political Interest. Scores were produced by summing the scores for each:

The Interest score was constructed for questions answered by R in the same
way as the Knowledge score.

Calculation of final PKI score

The final Political Knowledge-Interest score is
 $((PK + PI) / 200) * 100$ [rounded to next percent]

The closest possible approximation of quintiles for the final score categorized ratings as follows:

0-31	=LOW
32-48	=LOW-MEDIUM
49-59	=MEDIUM
60-74	=MEDIUM-HIGH
75-100	=HIGH
