## TECHNICAL REPORT #51 NES Question Batteries Measuring Values and Predispositions, 1983-1994

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The following pages chart the appearance of question batteries used to measure values and predispositions in NES Traditional Times Series and Pilot Studies data collections. The source for the report is the NES Continuity Guide, updated through 1993, supplemented by reference to questionnaires and codebooks for the 1994 NES and the various Pilot Studies. The entries in each cell are variable numbers for the ICPSR release of the data.

The boundaries between measures of values and predispositions on the one hand, and policy positions on the other hand, are not always clear. For the purposes of this document, we have opted to construe "values and predispositions" quite narrowly. Essentially, we include here only those measures which the Board explicitly decided to treat as values and predispositions, e.g., egalitarianism.

The content areas included are:
